With reference to the tender document which was launched on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023 and considering the **clause 3.4.4** of the tender document (How to submit tenders) and **clause 3.4.6**. (opening of tenders)

Considering the request from some of the interested bidders for additional period to better prepare the proposals for this tender.

We are pleased to announce that the **clause 3.4.4** of the tender document: "How to submit tenders" and **clause 3.4.6**. (opening of tenders) are slightly modified as follow:

- The new deadline for submission of bids is extended for additional 28 days and new submission date is scheduled for not later than <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>January 16<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>2024</u> <u>at 10:00 a.m</u> Kigali time to allow interested bidders to submit their bids/proposals.
- The new public opening of tenders is scheduled on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>January 16<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>2024</u> <u>at 10:30 a.m</u>

The rest of these clauses of the INITIAL TENDER DOCUMENT which are not modified by this addendum remain unchanged and other clauses of the tender documents remain valid.

Page 41 of the TORs it says that 'The Client shall provide training space facilities in the selected TVET schools', but it does not state that the client provides the technical equipment and material to conduct the technical training mentioned on page 35 of the ToRs. Who is covering for this training material of practical vocational training?

Districts will provide training venue for free. The rest should be budgeted under the financial proposal.

Page 37 of the ToRs 70 days are given to conduct the training on TVET. How do you think it will be possible to give technical training to e.g 700 start-ups in e.g carpentry, tailoring, farming, food processing, etc with just 70 expert days. Will you provide additional trainer capacities with partnering TVET? or please define the maximum number of start-ups benefiting from TVET training

The distribution of Man-days in ToRs is only indicative, the bidder is free to propose the suitable distributions.

Skills needs need to be assessed and support based on gaps identified, may not be identical for all beneficiaries.

We seek clarification regarding the eligibility of international experts who possess a strong understanding of the Rwanda context but might not be fluent in Kinyarwanda. Typically, we arrange for translation services during training sessions.

Please note that the minimum requirements (including the mastery of Kinyarwanda for some of the key experts) have been set based on the nature of assignment, and should be used for the selection stage, to ensure proper implementation of assignments, by the winner of the tender.
