**Contract title:** Public works contract for installation of Solar Powered Irrigation Schemes (SPIS) in the provinces of Zambezia and Manica (Mozambique)

N°	Issue / question raised	Response
1.	Does the RFI require the main contractor to be a single legal entity to take on all contractual liabilities, or is a consortium approach also acceptable, so long as it is clear which entities within the consortium are taking on which liabilities?	Single legal entity (eventually with subcontractor) OR consortium is possible. In case of Consortium, the identification form must be fill and sign by mandatories who have the right to commit each entity. A signed consortium agreement must be join to the bid. All the requirement for administrative regularity must be provided by each member of the consortium ( tax and social security certificates).
2.	If the RFI requires a single legal entity to take on all contractual liabilities, can named subcontractors in the response support the bid by also providing relevant references to meet that requirement	The tenderer must join to his bid subcontractor details signed by the subcontractor - see form 6.3 Third-party capacity – Forma engagement (optional)
3.	If sub-contractors from outside Mozambique are included e.g. to supply pumps, can their relevant references be included to meet that requirement?	Yes
4.	Is there any provision or approach suggested for hedging Euro currency risks, where costs are incurred in other currencies e.g. in dollars. Is there a recommended approach for this, or should each bidder include Euro hedging costs in their bid costs to reflect the related cash flows?	For this tender the price must be submitted in Euro, so the tenderer has to calculate the fluctuation rate risk in his prices
5.	Does the project bond need to be posted by the main contractor?	Yes
6.	In the tender document we find two reference options, on page 14 (3 similar works, amount of the project equivalent to or greater Than 100000 Euro) and on page 45 (2 similar works, amount of the project equivalent or greater than 150000	This is a mistake, please take in consideration the requirement set page 14: <b>The tenderer must provide in their offer the list of 3 similar works, involving infrastructural works related to agricultural activities, with a proven track record of</b>

	<p>Euro). Which of the two references should be taken into consideration?</p>	<p><b>successfully completing works in remote rural areas. The amount of the project must equivalent to or greater than 100.000 Euro each (Excl. VAT), delivered in the last 5 years, including the amount involved and the relevant dates, and the public or private bodies on behalf of which they were carried out showing that the tenderer has experience in performing those works.</b></p>
