1.1 Important errata and updates

No important errata are being published as part of these questions and answers.

1.2 Administrative and Technical Questions

1. Kindly share the technical specifications for each Lot.

Answer: The detailed technical specifications for all Lots are provided in the Framework Agreement's technical specifications Excel sheet, Annex (1): Bill of Material (BoM).

2. Regarding lot no 4, Item No. 4 – Heavy duty business colour multifunction printer A3. Is it possible to lower the scan speed for a minimum of 70 ipm?

Answer: Yes, the minimum scan speed requirement may be revised to a **minimum of 70 ipm**, provided that all other technical specifications and functionalities remain compliant with the requirements of the Framework Agreement.

3. Since we have limitation of delivering hardware to east Jerusalem with zero vat invoices (Israeli restrictions), could we make all deliveries to Ramallah office instead?

Answer: No, the successful contractor shall deliver the equipment to the location designed by the Contracting Authority, including east Jerusalem where applicable.

4. For expected multiple increasing prices for PC, Laptops ...etc. Could we make multiple prices for time phases along the agreement frame to be fair with offered prices for each time.

Answer: No. Tenderers shall submit fixed unit prices valid for the entire duration of the Framework Agreement.

Equivalent or newer models may be proposed during the framework period, subject to prior approval by the Contracting Authority, provided that they meet or exceed the required specifications and are offered at no additional cost.

5. Is it possibility to reduce the validity period of the prices.

Answer: No, tenderers shall submit fixed unit prices valid for the entire duration of the Framework Agreement, which starts upon award notification and ends on 31 December 2027.
