

## Tender 2275PSE-10116 - Questions and answers

### 1.1 Important errata and updates

No important errata are being published as part of these questions and answers.

### 1.2 Administrative and Technical Questions

- 1. Page 46 – List of References: Since we have annual contracts with several clients for more than one year, how should the contract value be reported in the reference list?**

Answer:

Report contracts signed within the past three years using the total value for that period. Annual or recurring contracts with the same beneficiary will count as a single similar assignment—use the combined value for up to three years and attach the signed contracts covering that period and value. You must also provide two additional distinct similar assignments from other beneficiaries.

- 2. Non-Conviction Certificate: Is the non-conviction certificate required only for the members of the Board of Directors, or should it also be provided for all proposed team members involved in the tender?**

Answer:

Non sentence certificates are required for all board members listed on the registration certificate and for their delegates.

- 3. Identification Forms: We noted that there are three different identification forms included in the tender documents. Could you please clarify which form(s) we are required to complete and submit, and explain the purpose or distinction between each form?**

Answer:

- Identification Form — Legal Person: For private companies, partnerships, NGOs or any corporate/taxable entities.
- Identification Form — Public Actor (Entity): For government bodies, public institutions or other state-owned entities participating in the tender.
- Identification Form — Natural Person: For individuals participating in the tender (e.g., sole proprietors, individual experts or proposed team members who are natural persons).

- 4. Recommendation Letters and Completion Certificates: Are both recommendation letters and completion certificates required as supporting documentation, or are recommendation letters alone sufficient?**

Answer:

Completion certificates are required. Each certificate must: state the contract value, indicate the contract's general purpose, confirm the contract period (within May 2023–present), and be signed and stamped by the awarding entity. Recommendation letters alone are not sufficient.

- 5. Regarding video production: We suggest specifying the number of shooting days for each video. This is important for determining production costs. We would like to know if it's possible to provide an approximate number of shooting days for each video?**

Answer:

Tenderers must price their financial proposals using the unit price specified in the tender; evaluation will be based on those unit price.

- 6. Regarding drone photography: We have received information from official Palestinian sources that this type of photography has been prohibited by a decision of the Israeli occupation. Will you be coordinating this matter and granting us permission to conduct this photography?**

Answer:

If any assignment requires this specific service, it will be discussed at that time. We will not place any service provider in a situation that is unlawful or exposes them to undue responsibility. It is not known for how long this restriction will remain in place, and we cannot provide any coordination support. Companies can add their price, while we will discuss further with the selected company for each individual case whenever this service is needed.
