Clarification of eligibility criteria and extension of deadline

The guidelines for applicants are hereby amended and clarified as follows:

1. Local presence requirement

Section 2.1.1 – Admissibility of applicants, criterion B is replaced by the following:

B. be legally established and registered in Mozambique and have a formal operational presence in Mozambique. A local implementing partner may support the delivery of the action but cannot, on its own, satisfy the applicant's local presence requirement.

Accordingly, an applicant that is not registered in Mozambique cannot satisfy the local presence requirement solely through a letter of commitment, MoU or other agreement with a locally registered implementing partner.

2. Eligibility of for-profit legal entities with social objectives

For-profit legal entities whose primary purpose is not profit maximization are eligible as already provided for in the Guidelines.

The following additional conditions apply to such entities:

- the applicant must demonstrate clear social objectives through its legal or strategic documentation;
- more than 50% of profits must, on average, have been reinvested in the business over the previous three years, with transparent profit distribution;
- the applicant must report externally on the achievement of its social objectives;
- the applicant must provide **at least 10% co-financing of the total action budget**; and
- applicable State aid/de minimis requirements must be respected.

The co-financing may include eligible staff time not charged to the grant, provided that it is properly documented and valued.

For example, for the maximum grant of EUR 220,000, the applicant may propose a total action budget of EUR 242,000, including EUR 22,000 in applicant co-financing.

Applicants must provide sufficient supporting documentation to demonstrate compliance with these conditions.

3. Optimisation phase

The section “2nd phase: opening, administrative checks, admissibility and evaluation of proposals” is complemented by the following provision, to be inserted after section 4. Selection and before the notification of the contracting authority's decision :

5. Optimisation

After the full proposals have been selected, the applicant(s) provisionally chosen may be invited by Enabel to participate in an optimisation phase before the grant agreement is signed.

During this phase, Enabel may provide the applicant(s) concerned with structured and reasoned feedback, based on observations from the evaluation, in order to clarify, strengthen or adjust certain elements of the proposal and improve its clarity, coherence and operational effectiveness.

The optimisation phase is conducted exclusively with the applicant(s) provisionally chosen. It does not constitute a renegotiation of the grant, a modification of the award decision or a reopening of the competitive process. Any adjustments requested or agreed during this phase may not call into question the elements that formed the basis for the selection of the proposal.

Following the optimisation phase, where applicable, Enabel will finalise the grant award and proceed with the preparation and signing of the grant agreement.

4. Extension of the Submission Deadline

The deadline for submission of concept notes is hereby extended to:

18 September 2026 at 23:55 (11:55 PM) Mozambique time.

All other provisions of the tender documents Enabel Mozambique ref. MOZ22005-10074 remain unchanged.
