

MINUTES OF THE NON-COMPULSORY INFORMATION MEETING

Contract title: Public supply contract for Supply, delivery, and installation of medical equipment items and sundries for KIDA hospital in Kabarole district and Kagando hospital in Kasese district

Reference: UGA21003-10366

The non-compulsory information meeting was held on 13th August 2026 at 10:00 am, Kampala time.

N°	Issue/question raised	Response
1.	Is the required minimum of 1 assignment intended for a tenderer or the equipment manufacturer?	The required previous assignment is for the tenderer. It's intended to show that the tenderer has delivered similar supplies for other entities as part of the selection criteria.
2.	Will the performance bond be required from a contractor if the contract value is below 50,000 Euros?	No, the performance bond is a requirement for the public contract when the total value exceeds 50,000 Euros excluding VAT and is set at 5% of the total value. The resulting value will be rounded up to the nearest 10 euros (See Section 8, "Performance bond") of the tender document. However, tenderers are encouraged to cross check market rates for the items to be supplied prior to submitting a financial offer as the contracting authority will perform a check on abnormally low prices.
3.	Is a partial bid allowed or the tenderer must bid for all the items listed?	No, the items are grouped together to form one single contract. It is not possible to tender for one, or several items and the tenderer must submit price quotations for all items of the contract (See Section 2, "Items") of the tender document.
4.	If the tenderer does not have a subcontractor, should they submit the subcontractor form?	No, the tenderer should not submit a subcontractor form if they are not subcontracting the tender however a tenderer should submit a subcontractor form if they are subcontracting the tender.

5.	Can Enabel provide its Tax Identification Number (TIN) to the tenderers to support processing the tax clearance certificates.	The TIN for Enabel is 1000104454. However, the tax clearance certificate shall be required from the successful tenderer as stated in the tender document. (See Sub-section 6.9 of the tender document).
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
