

Addendum n°1 to the Tender TZA25001-10037 Public service contract for “Consultancy Services for Venture Sourcing, Matchmaking and Entrepreneur Exchange Program in Tanzania, Uganda and Senegal”

With reference to the tender published on 07 September 2026, the Contracting Authority hereby amends the tender as follows:

1. ESPD Requirement

Amends: Section D, Clause 13

This is hereby amended by adding the following:

13.9 By submitting this tender together with the completed European Single Procurement Document (ESPD), the tenderer declares officially on his honour that:

- he is not in one of the mandatory or facultative exclusion cases, which must or may lead to his exclusion.
- he fulfils the selection criteria established by the contracting authority in this public contract

The European Single Procurement Document (ESPD) is a self-declaration by economic operators providing preliminary evidence replacing the certificates issued by public authorities or third parties.

As provided in Article 73 of the Law of 17 June 2016, it is a formal statement by the economic operator that it is not in one of the situations in which economic operators shall or may be excluded; that it meets the relevant selection criteria.

The tenderer can either complete the ESPD given in attachment, or generate his document via the website: <https://ec.europa.eu/tools/espd/filter>

Where the tender is submitted by a group of economic operators under partnership, it must include an ESPD for each of the participants in the group.

In accordance with Article 38 §2 of Article 73 of the Royal Decree of 18 April 2017, regarding part IV of the ESPD on the selection criteria, the contracting authority has decided to limit the information to be filled out to one single question, namely whether the economic operator fulfils the required selection criteria, in accordance with the section "Global indication for all selection criteria". So, only this section must be completed.

Tenderers are required to submit a duly completed European Single Procurement Document (ESPD) as part of their tender.

2. List of Documents

Chapter 7 is amended by adding the following document to the list of documents to be submitted as part of the tender:

(j) A duly completed European Single Procurement Document (ESPD). Where a tender is submitted by a group of economic operators, a separate ESPD must be submitted for each participant in the group.

3. Submission Deadline

Amends: The cover page and Section C, Clauses 10.4 and 12.1

All references in the Tender Specifications to the tender submission deadline, including on the cover page and in Section C, Clauses 10.4 and 12.1, are hereby replaced with **14 October 2026 at 4:00 p.m. East Africa Time (EAT).**

All other provisions of the Tender Specifications remain unchanged. This addendum forms an integral part of the Tender Specifications and must be taken into account when preparing and submitting a tender.
